Urs officially opens the session.

TOP 1 Freshmen

Tutorials: There have been more Bachelor students actively participating in the tutorial than last week. Let's hope they keep using this offer.

Some of the Master students were missing forms, but this problem should be solved by now.

TOP 2 Answering mails

TOP 4 Buying Stuff

As we want to keep the hot plate inside of our SR room and only use it carefully for events this hopefully shouldn't be a problem.

Other ideas for spending money:

- Chairs for the SR room: Before buying new chairs we should first check if there are any chairs left within the institute.
- Beanbag: 7 of us are in favor and 2 were abstaining for applying for a beanbag (below 75€).
- Christmas decoration: A singing Christmas tree that gets aggressive when you try to plug it out.

TOP 5 Session Slot

TOP 6 (Team) Events

Games night: 04.11.2022.

Pub crawl: 18.11.2022. **VB** creates a google document and sends email with it to students.

Climbing: In December. **Marc** checks for possible dates and gets a poll-creator to do a doodle.

Halloween: Some of us want to do something on Monday (31.10.2022) in the evening together. Let's just meet and plan then what to do / where to go.

Christmas Party: There should be a Christmas party this year! We need to figure out a date. Let's make a poll where we can enter when we are planning to leave Stuttgart/we assume the internationals might leave. We shouldn't spam all students with this kind of poll. Thus let only us SR participate in it. Additionally we could make a poll on Discord where also other IMS-students could show their opinion.

IMS-weekend:

- Idea: Let's organize a winter-weekend for 3 days / 2 nights (over the weekend, from Friday till Sunday) in the black forest (reachable via public transportation) around January/February. It's supposed to be open for all IMS-students and of course former IMS students (including Fabian).
- We need to plan this weekend! => Lots of information can be found in the stuvus-wiki download-section.
- It would be great to get some financial support from stuvus:

- If we comply with stuvus' sustainability guideline for food we should get some additional support.
- For buying food it would be possible to apply for a Metro-card via stuvus.
- In case we need a car, stuvus might have special conditions with Stadtmobil.
- We can borrow things like a sound system from stuvus.
- Problem: It's hard to estimate how many students might be interested in participating in an IMS-weekend. (But: This estimate is somewhat needed to be able to calculate the price for accommodation and food.) We might want to create a poll beforehand to just check the general interest without details on the weekend itself. There should be multiple options available in the poll, e.g. "YES I want to participate if it costs less than X€", "NO I'm not interested in participating". We could also let them state a preferred date.
- Next week we should make a time-plan with milestones and start delegating tasks.

Urban	Reminds VB [to create the google document and send the invitation for the games night & pub crawl to the students].
Max	Creates a doodle asking when students are leaving for Christmas.
Fabian	Checks for how much in advance we need to apply for stuvus supporting student-weekends.
Sven	Creates a google document asking for the general interest of IMS students in participating in an IMS-weekend. Creates a google document with TODOs (= things we need to consider when planning an IMS-weekend).
Max & Marc	Take a look into stuvus' financial support for food and figure out a rough estimate of the amount of money we need to spend for food.
Sofia & Urban	Take a look into possible dates and accommodations.

TOP 7 Old protocols (Nextcloud)
