

# Minutes FSCL Meeting 2022/11/24

## TOP 1 Freshmen

Everything seems fine.

Issue: Some of the freshman can't enter the building with their ECUS-card.

As this might be an issue for multiple students we should consider writing to all students an email. But: This will eventually lead to a huge email spam for Edgar. Thus we first need to contact Edgar how he wants to handle the problem.

<b>Urban</b>	Answers freshmen (who mentioned the issue) that they should write an email to Edgar.
<b>Urs</b>	Contacts Edgar and asks him about how he wants to handle the problem.

## TOP 2 Answering mails

Email "Tour de FGen am 08.12 in Vaihingen um 18 Uhr, bitte um Anmeldung":

- The Tour de FGen is happening on 08.12.2022.
- Questions: Do we want to participate? Do we want to offer a station?
- In case of offering a station we would need to take care of the room reservation and we would need to buy drinks. As our SR room is quite small and other SR groups might offer more we don't want to offer a station this semester. Still about 7 student representatives (from the present students in this meeting) want to participate.

<b>Sven</b>	Replies to Lucia telling that we won't offer a station, but we will participate with ca. 7 people.
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*The other mails were classified as irrelevant.*

## TOP 3 Buying Stuff

Games night: We wait for the reply from stuvus about the games night bill.

Table tennis table: Stuvus approved buying a new table tennis table. We need to check how to set the billing address. **Urs** calls the seller to get more information on this.

Kitchen stuff: Only want to order the sandwich maker. **Sven** informs stuvus that we want to order the sandwich maker.

Others: cloth bags, stickers

We should try to collect more money -> Ideas: Christmas party, Tour de FGen

Games night: Urs received the money from stuvus for the expenses. Urs forwarded the money to Sven who paid for the games night.

Table tennis plate: The order happened on Tuesday. It says that it'll take 6 to 10 working days until the table tennis plate will be delivered.

The Pfand was taken away. Now there's 20€ in the Getränkekeasse.

## TOP 4 (Team) Events

Pub crawl: Friday, 18.11.2022, at 18:30 starting at the IMS. Plan with 10-12 persons per group, max. 2 groups.

Climbing: In January. **Marc** checks for possible dates and gets a poll-creator to do a doodle.

Christmas party: On Friday 16.12.2022. The Hörsaalmanagement needs to approve the event. We want a proper program. There's still mulled wine and a cooker in the basement. **Urs** invites students/employees and asks them for contributions.

**Urs** asks the secretaries for financial support from the institute. **Fabian** searches for the code of the Human Markov Chain.

IMS-weekend: 3 days / 2 nights (over the weekend), in black forest (reachable via public transportation), around January / February. Stuvus financially supports the weekend somehow. Limit the number of people to  $35 \pm 5$ ; we have a list of accommodations, we further need to filter it according to price, availability and location. Financial support from stuvus: 25€ food (if 2/5 sustainability criteria met) and 22€ accommodation (if people still pay at least 10€ themselves) per person per day. **Max and Fabian** call hosts to get further information on availability and prices.

IMS-weekend: So far the list of places contains 7 locations. We tried contacting them, but almost all of them didn't respond. Thus we need to further try to contact the hosts. The goal is to make calls and bring all things together until Monday noon to be able to decide on one place. By now there's one acceptable option which has not the perfect location, but is cheap (costs about 800€ for all of us) and available on the first weekend (= 03.02.2023 - 05.02.2023). Keeping in mind that the "Methods in CL"-exam is happening shortly after the second weekend, organizing the trip on the first weekend might be better.

The pubcrawl was a success. A lot of students participated 😊. We should also do it next semester!

Christmas party: The Hörsaalmanagement replied that we don't need to get their approval for this kind of events – the approval / reservation from Edgar should be enough. So far nobody (neither IMS students nor IMS staff) added ideas to the google doc. We might need to reach out to the professors individually (via mail or in person?). There are several aspects that need to be organized in advance. We should build a "logistics"-group taking care of these: Urban, Jolanda, Sven and Max will make a list of equipment we need (e.g. Do we have enough mugs?), plan how to set up the tables and chairs, ... and will put their results in the already existing google document. In case we need to buy things it would be interesting to know if we get financial support from the institute.

Idea: We should visit the Christmas market. We want to do so on 06.12.2022 in the afternoon/evening. We still need to decide where to go and if we either make it a SR-only event or also invite all IMS-students.
